

**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
FOR COOPERATION BETWEEN
THE DIPLOMATIC ACADEMY OF THE MINISTRY OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS OF
THE REPUBLIC OF KOSOVO
AND DIPLOMACY ACADEMY OF THE MINISTRY OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS OF
THE REPUBLIC OF TURKEY**

The Diplomatic Academy of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Kosovo and the Diplomacy Academy of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Turkey agree to sign the following Memorandum of Understanding for the purpose of furthering mutually beneficial cooperation for the training in the field of diplomacy and the exchange of information on topics of international law, diplomatic law and other academic disciplines that are relevant for the practice of diplomacy and international relations, be they political, economic, cultural, financial, or other.

ARTICLE I

The Diplomatic Academy of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Kosovo and the Diplomacy Academy of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Turkey may maintain an active exchange of information about their respective study programmes and other relevant academic activities.

ARTICLE II

Both institutions may facilitate the exchange of academics, conference speakers, experts and researchers in the areas that are of their common interest. Both institutions may encourage the lectures and presentations given particularly by their officials in the framework of their training programs.

ARTICLE III

Both institutions may consult on the possibilities of organizing courses and seminars that could be held alternately in Prishtina and Ankara.

ARTICLE IV

Both institutions may facilitate the exchange of their respective publications, as well as pertinent texts from other public or private institutions from their respective countries.

ARTICLE V

Both institutions may exchange information related to activities of common interest, taking into special consideration the participation in meetings of regional and international character that involve academics and other academic institutions offering training for diplomats.

ARTICLE VI

Each Party will fulfill its obligations undertaken by this Memorandum of Understanding in conformity with the legislation of their respective countries. This Memorandum of Understanding shall not constitute or be interpreted as an international agreement between the States of the Parties. No provision of this Memorandum of Understanding shall be interpreted and implemented as creating legal rights or commitments for the States of the Parties.

ARTICLE VII

The present Memorandum of Understanding shall enter into force on the day after its signing and shall be valid for 3 years. Unless one of the parties notifies the other of its intention to terminate the MOU in a written form at least 90 days before the date of expiry, its validity will be extended for periods of three years.

Signed in the City of Prishtina, on the 3th August 2012, in two originals in Albanian, Serbian, Turkish and English languages, all texts being equally authentic. In case of divergence of interpretation, the English text shall prevail.


